# WORKING OUT YOUR TRIP

### **HOW TO RIDE**

#### 1. Find where you want to go

Make sure you go to the correct platform (northbound/southbound)

#### 2. Buy and validate your ticket

Check out the back page to see the tickets that can be used on board the G: Remember to 'touch on' with your Gold Coast *go explore* card or *go* card before boarding the tram.

#### 3. Get on board

Push the lit button on the door. Let passengers exit the tram before you get on, and hold on at all times while on board the G:

#### 4. Exit the tram

Make sure that you are prepared and ready to exit the tram as you pull into the station, to allow time for the other passengers to board. Push the lit button to open the doors.

#### 5. Leave the station

Remember to 'touch off' with your Gold Coast *go* explore card or *go* card before leaving the station.
