## Passing of "old boy" Roy Nunn

It is with sadness that we inform members of the recent passing of one of our "old boys", Roy Nunn. Roy was a member of our Club during the 1960's and 1970's with one of his best mates. Mick Power, a Life Member of BMD Northcliffe and Group Board Chairman of the BMD Group, our Naming Rights Sponsors. Our thoughts and prayers are with Roy's family and friends. Please see below excerpt from the Courier Mail, noting Roy's extraordinary life.



He graced the stages of Queensland theatres for decades but this 'inspirational talent' will leave an emptiness on stage after his sudden passing. He graced the stages of theatres around QLD for decades with his peers describing him as "one of the best". But talented actor and singer, Roy Nunn, has left an emptiness on stage after his recent sudden death which left his community shocked and saddened. The man, who lived and arew up in Wynnum, starred on stage for many different groups over the years, including Savoyards Musical Theatre, Mercury Theatre, MATES Theatre and the Villanova Plavers.

Mr Nunn, 71, was farewelled in what his friends called "one last sold out show" in a memorial at the Wynnum Manly Leagues Club on Thursday, where the more than 240 people in attendance joined in singing is favourite song, Imagine by John Lennon.

MATES Theatre president, Suzy harper, said. "And the carpools on the way to see shows, will miss his singing and even his terrible back seat driving through the suburbs."

Roy Nunn's much-loved guitar on stage at his memorial. The man and father to daughters and several grandchildren, who was loved and respected by the bayside and theatre community, with one of Mr Nunn's friends calling him a "gentleman's gentleman". "He was one of the kindest, thoughtful, gently spoken men I ever had the privilege of knowing," artistic director of the Phoenix Ensemble, Shane Webb, said. "Roy was a talent and an inspiration and a sheer privilege to work beside, one of the best." At his memorial, son-inlaw Aaron Wyeth shared stories of Mr Nunn's life, a calling him a "renaissance man".

Actor Anne Pensalfini also paid tribute to her fallen friend. "Roy was a funny, engaged, bold and generous actor, who persevered despite difficulties with vision," she said. "His wit and love for life and theatre was evident in everything he did." Mrs Harper said Mr Nunn would be sorely missed by everyone who knew him.
